

## **SERGEI RACHMANINOFF HEARD**

**Russian Composer and Pianist Plays  
at the Metropolitan.**

Sergei Rachmaninoff, the Russian composer-pianist, was the principal soloist at last night's concert at the Metropolitan Opera House. He played six of his own compositions, including the famous C sharp minor prelude, all of which he had previously played at a recital he had given here at Carnegie Hall. Besides these piano numbers Mme. Anna Meltschik and Mr. Didur each sang two of his songs.

The other soloists were Mr. Forsell, who sang an air from "Der Fliegende Holländer"; Mr. Jörn, and Mme. Jane Osborne-Hannah. The orchestra was under the direction of Max Bendix.
