

Noted Pianist In Concert Here Tonight

Rachmaninoff Arrives From Harlingen at Noon

Sergei Rachmaninoff, 67-year-old piano virtuoso, famous conductor and composer, arrived here at noon today from Harlingen to appear in concert at 8:15 o'clock tonight at Senior High School auditorium under the auspices of the Civic Music Association. His appearance last night in the Valley was CMA-sponsored also.

Music lovers in the city are anticipating an evening of music such as most have never had before. Rachmaninoff is the star of this year's program and a capacity house will greet him tonight.

Included on the program are three of the composer's numbers: "Humoresque" (newly revised), "Moment Musical" (newly revised) and "Etude-Tableau," E Flat Major. He will also play Mendelssohn's "Rondo Capriccioso," favorite of many musicians, two numbers by Chopin, several by Liszt and Beethoven and one by Tausig, "Variations on a Theme of Schubert."

Doors to the auditorium will be closed at 8:15 and all persons arriving late will not be admitted until intermission. Only holders of memberships in the association will be allowed to attend.
