

Audience in Sit-down Against Rachmaninoff

New York, Nov. 9.—(AP.)—New York music lovers staged a genuine sit-down strike against pianist Serge Rachmaninoff today, and forced the world-famous musician to play a half-hour beyond his scheduled time.

When Rachmaninoff finished his regular program of nocturnes and mazurkas, the Carnegie Hall audience before whom he performed just held to their seats, refusing to move.

The great Rachmaninoff kept right on playing for another half-hour.
