

To Appear in Savannah

**SAVANNAH WILL HEAR
RACHMANINOFF PLAY**

SAVANNAH, Ga., Dec. 3.—Sergei Rachmaninoff, master pianist and among the foremost of contemporary composers, will be heard in a recital at the municipal auditorium in Savannah Wednesday evening, December 9. His concert in Savannah will be the only appearance of the great Russian in the southeast this season.

He was originally scheduled to play in Atlanta, but his date there was canceled because of the failure to have the auditorium completed in time. The Philadelphia Symphony orchestra has been substituted on the Atlanta series in the place of Rachmaninoff, it is said.

The Savannah program includes "Organ Fantasia and Fugue, G-minor," Bach-Liszt; "Sonata, No. 3, opus 10," Beethoven; "Polonaise, C-minor," "Mazurka" and "Rondo, opus 16," by Chopin; "Three Etudes-Tableaux, opus 33," Rachmaninoff; "Sonetto del Petrarca, No. 2," Liszt; "Two Studies," Paganini-Liszt; "Stude, E-Major," "Paganini-Liszt; "Invitation to the Dance," Weber-Tausig.

Rachmaninoff is the second attraction of the Savannah All-Star Concert Series, which is sponsored by the Junior League.
