
Rachmaninoff in Brooklyn Recital Next Monday Night.

Sergei Rachmaninoff, famous Russian composer and pianist, will give his annual Brooklyn recital at the Academy of Music next Monday evening, Feb. 27. It is within easy memory of Brooklyn music lovers that Rachmaninoff made his first appearance with the New York Symphony Orchestra at the Academy of Music nine years ago when the revolution in his native Russia brought him to this country. He has played here in recital several times since.

Rachmaninoff's programme for next week's Brooklyn recital includes: Sonata quasi una Fantasia (Beethoven), Fantasia quasi Sonata (Liszt), Fantasie in F minor, Polonaises in C minor and E flat major (Chopin), Fairy Tale, No. 1 (Medtner), Valse-Caprice, No. 1 (Strauss-Tausig), Prelude (Rachmaninoff).
