

NOTED PIANIST IS COMING HERE SOON

Rachmaninoff Will Reappear In Vancouver in Brilliant Programme.

For his concert here Tuesday, March 12, Rachmaninoff, outstanding figure in the world of music today, has chosen a programme of universal appeal. It begins with some of the abiding piano literature of all time and passes to present-day composers.

The evening will close with three pieces by the mysterious Russian, Scriabine, who initiated many arresting experiments in composition. Acquainted as he was with the composer in the latter's lifetime, Rachmaninoff's interpretations will be models of authenticity for teachers and students to copy.
