

Pianist Will Vary Recital

Rachmaninoff Offers Wide Selection.

Works by Beethoven, Bach, Schubert, Mendelssohn, Chopin and Liszt are on the program Sergei Rachmaninoff will play at his piano recital at Hoyt Sherman auditorium Monday night.

The concert, the third in the series being offered by the Des Moines Civic Music association, will begin at 8:15 p. m.

From Beethoven.

Rachmaninoff's Beethoven selection is the composer's Variations in C Minor, a monumental work varying in both construction and mood.

From Bach's work the Russian pianist has selected the Preludio, E Major, which, of course, contains revisions made by Rachmaninoff in adapting the piece from the harpsichord to the piano.

Representative.

As representative of Schubert's works, Rachmaninoff will give the Impromptu, F. Minor, and from Mendelssohn he has taken the Scherzo from "Midsummer Night's Dream."

Another interesting number will be Rachmaninoff's own Two Preludes.
