

Rachmaninoff in Recital

Sergei Rachmaninoff, distinguished Russian composer and pianist, will present a diversified program at his piano recital in the Academy of Music on Saturday afternoon, March 18, at 2.30 o'clock. At this time he will play the entire Set of Variations in C Minor by Beethoven; his own transcription of Bach's E-major Preludio from the Violin Sonata; Schumann's "Nachstück," Opus 23; Schubert's Impromptu in F-minor; the Weber-Tausig "Invitation to the Dance"; the Scherzo from Mendellsohn's "Midsummer Night's Dream" in Rachmaninoff's own transcription; three of the pianist's own Preludes — E-major, B-minor and A-minor; concluding with two Litz numbers, "Sonetto del Petrarca" and the Rhapsody No. 7.
