

## NOTED PIANIST PLEASES STAR COURSE CROWD

Lending eager ears, lest one of the exquisite notes be lost to them, a large audience of town and campus folk thrilled last night to the superb renditions of a great artist, Sergei Rachmaninoff, known the world over as one of the most brilliant of pianist composers.

Rachmaninoff, appearing in the university Stadium as the premiere attraction on the 1932-33 star course series, instilled within his performance that divine quality of feeling, that has placed him foremost among the ranks of living musicians.
