## SERGEI RACHMANINOFF

Loyal followers of the artistry of Sergei Rachmaninoff braved the cold last night to hear the great Russian pianist in his annual Brooklyn concert. The electric brilliance which is his characteristic style exposed unexpected richness in a number of pieces well-known and frequently played.

The program consisted of Variations in C Minor by Beethoven, Rondo by Schubert, the clever Carnival by Schumann, a Nocturne and a Ballade by Chopin; two preludes by Rachmaninoff, Scherzo by Borodine and the familiar Invitation to the Dance by Weber-Tausig, beautifully rendered.
