

Rachmaninoff at National.

Rachmaninoff, the great Russian pianist, will be heard in recital at the National Theater the last time this season next Thursday afternoon, March 31, at 4:30 o'clock, under the management of Mrs. Wilson-Greene. Mr. Rachmaninoff is a unique figure in the world of music today, being recognized as one of the world's greatest conductors, composer and pianist. His program will include: Chaconne (Bach-Busoni); Sonata No. 9 (Mozart); Papillons (Schumann); Nocturne, Valse, Polonaise (Chopin); Suite, "Children's Corner," (a) Doctor Gradus ad Parnassum, (b) Serenade of a Doll, (c) The Little Shepherd, (d) Golliwogg's Cake Walk, (Debussy); two preludes, G major and B flat major (Rachmaninoff).
