Rachmaninoff, To-night.

When Sergei Rachmaninoff, the eminent Russian pianist and composer, appears in Convention Hall to-night, he will be greeted by an audience, a large part of which heard his masterly playing last March when he came to Rochester for the first time. Since that notable success he has increased his popularity by his numerous concerts throughout the country. Wherever he has appeared during the few weeks of the present season, he has been acclaimed with enthusiasm.
