

# RACHMANINOFF TO PRESENT FAMOUS PRELUDE IN K. C.

During the war Sergei Rachmaninoff, distinguished Russian composer and pianist, who ranks with Paderewski, was asked to assist in the New York liberty loan drive. Rachmaninoff agreed.

As a climax, Rachmaninoff agreed to play his prelude in C sharp minor if persons in the audience would subscribe \$1,000,000 in Liberty bonds. Six men announced their willingness to buy that amount. He will play it here Wednesday night.
