### ***\$231.18 Realized for Fam- ine Fund at Concert by Rachmaninoff.***

"It is little to do for my unhappy people who need so much," replied Sergel Rachmaninoff, pianist, to Mrs. Booth Tarkington's thanks after his concert at the Murat theater yesterday afternoon, as he autographed programs for contributors in the audience of \$231.18 to the Indiana Russian famine fund. Mrs. Tarkington is chairman for Marion county in the collection for the starving peasants of Russia.

"For more than three years the earnings of Rachmaninoff have gone to help his countrymen and women," Charles J. Foley of Boston, manager of the artist, said. "Whatever he has been asked to do he has done, and it is distinctly his pleasure to be able to add to the funds being raised in Indiana to provide relief through the Quakers in the famine districts."
