

Rachmaninoff In Recital Tuesday

Few men in the world of art have attained the fame that has crowned the genius of Sergei Rachmaninoff, pianist, composer, conductor, who will give a piano recital Tuesday evening, February 7, in Orchestra hall.

This great artist has played twice before in Detroit and left behind him with those fortunate enough to have sat beneath the spell of his splendid artistry, a memory not to be effaced in the passing of years.
