

RACHMANINOFF TO APPEAR TONIGHT

With the certainty that his audience will want to hear him play some of his own well known compositions, Sergei Rachmaninoff who will be heard at the Poughkeepsie High School tonight, will play his own well known prelude in C sharp minor, as well as giving a polka of his own, a Bizet minuet which he has arranged and the second Liszt Rhapsodie, with a cazenda by the pianist. No doubt as encores, other well known compositions of his own, including his preludes in G major and in G minor.

The seat sale of tickets for tonight's concert has been heavy. The great Russian has never been heard in Poughkeepsie before and only a small number of Poughkeepsians have heard him in New York, so that interest among local music-lovers is great, and the concert is being anticipated with great pleasure.
