

## RACHMANINOFF'S PROGRAM CHANGED

A few changes are announced in the Rachmaninoff program to be given next Wednesday night at Carnegie music hall. Instead of the Beethoven Sonata Appassionata, Rachmaninoff will give Weber's Rondo Brilliant. Other numbers not previously announced include Moszowski's "La Jongleuse," Liszt "Etude, A Flat Major," and the Strauss-Schulz-Evler arrangement of the Beautiful Blue Danube. The numbers previously announced that remain are Medtner's Improvization, opus 31, the Chopin group including Polonaise, Nocturne, Valse and Sonata, opus 35, and Rachmaninoff's own Melodie and Serenade.
