

ANNOUNCE PROGRAM FOR CONCERT HERE BY RACHMANINOFF

The program to be given by Sergei Rachmaninoff, famous Russian pianist, who appears in the Coliseum Wednesday evening January 24 was announced today. According to Mrs. F. O. Allen, who is bringing the pianist to Shreveport, several of the numbers included in the program are request numbers suggested by local patrons, who have heard the famous pianist in other cities.

In addition to the program announced, Rachmaninoff will play several of his own compositions as encores.

Special interest is attached to the announcement that Schumann's Carnival is to be played, as this remarkable composition has not been heard in Shreveport in many years. It is said that Rachmaninoff handles this number with the

utmost sympathy for color, atmosphere and delicacy of outline and in a manner of which Schumann himself would have approved.
