## Rachmaninoff Program Announced

Rachmaninoff, who appears in concert at the Metropolitan theater Thursday evening, like many of the great composers, first won fame as a soloist. His present tour is, therefore, of special interest as it will serve to present more intimately his genius to a great and increasing number of American admirers.

Rachmaninoff is now in his early forties, and at the height of his powers. Not only is he justly regarded as one of the foremost living composers, but his magnificent playing stamps him as a truly great pianist as well.
