

## RACHMANINOFF IN RECITAL.

Sergei Rachmaninoff, the Russian musical giant and generally conceded the foremost pianist of this day, will be heard in recital at the Academy tomorrow evening, under Brooklyn Institute auspices. As a pianist, Rachmaninoff is the last word in exquisite refinement. His program will be one of compelling interest, including Medtner's "Improvisation"; "Rondo Brilliant," by Weber; a Chopin group, "Nocturne," "Valse," and the "Sonata in B. Flat Minor"; two original compositions, "Melodie" and "Serenade"; "La Jongleuse," by Moszkowski, and "Beautiful Blue Danube," by Strauss.
