

RACHMANINOFF WILL PLAY OWN COMPOSITIONS

Concert Monday Offers Tucson One of Outstanding World Musicians

Tucson will have an opportunity to hear not only one of the world's greatest pianists, but one of its best known modern Russian composers, when Sergei Rachmaninoff plays in concert Monday evening at the high school auditorium at 8:30 o'clock under the auspices of the Woman's Club.

Several of the pianist's selections will be his own compositions, notably his "Polonaise," which will be the concluding number on the program.

Rachmaninoff arrived in the city Saturday evening from the coast in company with L. E. Behymer. He will spend today and tomorrow in the city and after his program will go to fulfill other engagements.

The program is as follows:

1. Caprice, Air de Ballet, from Alceste, Gluck-Saint Saens.
2. Sonato, G minor, Schumann; Presto, Andantino, Allegro marcato, Presto.
3. (a) Scherzo, (b) Etude, (c) Ballade, Chopin.
4. (a) Etude Tableau, (b) Prelude; Rachmaninoff.
5. (a) Sonetto del Petrarca, Liszt; (b) Polonaise, Rachmaninoff.
