

FAMOUS RUSSIAN PIANIST PLAYS IN CANTON THURSDAY

Sergei Rachmaninoff, world famous Russian pianist, will make his first appearance in Canton, Thursday evening, November 12, when he gives a recital in the Canton Auditorium. Rachmaninoff is one of the few great artists who have not yet appeared in Canton. Only three Ohio cities will be visited by Rachmaninoff this season as he is only playing six weeks of concert engagements.

Nearly every student of the piano at one time or other has attempted to play some of Rachmaninoff's compositions, especially his C-sharp minor Prelude, which will be included in the Canton program. Russian music of the "new school" will be included in the recital together with Rachmaninoff's own compositions, which always show the composer at his best.

According to R. D. Smith, who is bringing Rachmaninoff to Canton, the famous pianist has played before many record audiences in the concert halls. Smith has managed Rachmaninoff concerts in twenty-five cities, and states that he would rather offer Rachmaninoff to a music-loving audience than any other artist on the concert stage—for Rachmaninoff always satisfies his audience, and leaves them cheering for more.

Rachmaninoff uses specially built pianos and always carries two with him in case of accident to one of them. An expert from the factory accompanies them and tunes and adjusts them to the various halls.

It is expected that many New Philadelphia patrons will attend the Rachmaninoff recital as it is regarded as the biggest concert
