

RACHMANINOFF HERE.

Russian Pianist Appears at the Academy of Music.

Sergei Rachmaninoff, the eminent Russian composer, pianist and conductor, appeared under institute auspices Monday evening at the Academy of Music. This master of music, has been attracting increasing audiences ever since his coming to this country, and his rank in the musical world is such as to justify the popular acclaim.

Rachmaninoff's programme for Monday evening included, in addition to compositions of his own, some of those of the great masters of the past. The programme included: Sonata No. 9 (Mozart), "Tema con variations, Menuetto Rondo alla Turcia;" "Five Songs Without Words" (Mendelssohn), Nos. 32, 3, 47, 37, 17, and selections from Chopin, Rachmaninoff and Liszt.
