

RACHMANINOFF HEARD.

Splendid Performance at Academy of Music Last Night.

An appreciative audience that packed the concert hall of the Academy of Music last evening heard one of the finest piano recitals given in Brooklyn for a long time. Sergei Rachmaninoff was the artist. He played selections from such composers as Liszt, Grieg, Chopin, Kreisler and Dohnanyi. Rachmaninoff has temperament and a winning personality. His interpretation of a group of Chopin's selections was exceptionally fine.

Ballade No. 2 (Liszt): Ballade, Op. 24 (Grieg): Ballade No. 3, Nocturne, Op. 27, Valse, D flat major, Scherzo, Op. 39 (Chopin); Elegie, Op. 3, Polka de W. R. (Rachmaninoff): Etude, Capriccio, Op. 28 (Dohnanyi); Liebesleid (Kreisler-Rachmaninoff); Tarantella, Venezia e Napoli (Liszt).
