Two Etudes, Opus 3—Schuman-Paganini.

II.

Eight Etudes, from Opus 10 and 25—Chopin.

III.

Five Etudes—Tableaux, from Opus 33 and 39—Rachmaninoff.

IV.

Etudes—(a) Alkan (As the Wind) (b) Rubinstein, Opus 81, (c) Scriabine, Opus 42.

V.

Three Etudes—(a) Dance of the Gnomes, Franz Liszt, (b) D-flat Major, Franz Liszt, (c) Campanella, Paganini-Liszt.
