

Rachmaninoff to Play Etude Program Today

Mr Rachmaninoff's second concert of music for the piano at Symphony Hall this afternoon offers a program of works by Chopin, Liszt and three Russian compositions, Rubinstein, Scriabine and the Russian pianist himself.

Chopin's Sonata in B minor, op 58, opens the program; group two is by the same composer, four Etudes op 39. Mr Rachmaninoff will play his own four Etudes (Tableaux) op 39, for the third group, while Rubinstein's Etude, op 81, and Scriabine's Etude, op 42, make up group four. The program closes with the "Dance of the Gnomes" and Etude in D-flat major, by Liszt, and his arrangement of Paganini's "Campanella."
