

RACHMANINOFF PLAYS AT THE ODEON TONIGHT

The long looked for appearance of Sergei Rachmaninoff will be realized when the distinguished Russian composer-pianist appears at the Odeon tonight in recital. As the dominant figure in music today, Rachmaninoff's vogue is equal to that of Paderewski at the height of his powers. In all centers visited capacity audiences greet the great virtuoso, whose playing conveys mood, poetry, illusion and emotion as his imagination meets and intensifies the imagination of the composer.

Rachmaninoff's program tonight gives full play for his manifold gifts and happily includes two of his own compositions for which he is quite as famed as for his pianism.
