

FAMOUS RUSSIAN ARTIST A GUEST HERE TODAY

Rachmaninoff Plays at Con- vention Hall Tonight— Arrived This Morning.

Sergei Rachmaninoff was out of humor today. By the Little Father there was enough to be out of sorts!

The great Russian pianist was not allowed to have a piano in his room at the Bisonte. No, not even a Rachmaninoff might have one. It is not permitted. So!

The famous pianist arrived in Hutchinson this morning from Colorado Springs, where he has been resting for several days. He is accompanied by John C. Paul, a representative of Steinway & Sons. The Russian artist will give a concert today at Convention hall, the only one in Kansas on this tour, which makes it a notable event.

Tonight after the concert he will go to Kansas City and from there to Chicago and in New York city, he will join his wife and daughters. The elder daughter, who is 16, is a student of Bryn Mawr college.

At his concert tonight Rachmaninoff will break his custom of playing on one of his own pianos, which he ships with him on his trips, and will use a local instrument.
