

Rachmaninoff, Burned Here, Cancels Concert

Sergei Rachmaninoff, internationally-known pianist, has been forced to cancel a concert at Dallas, Tex., as the result of an accident here Tuesday night in which he burned two fingers on his right hand.

Rachmaninoff had gone to his suite at Hotel Statler following completion of his concert at Mu-

unicipal Auditorium under sponsorship of the Civic Music League. Following his usual practice, he applied a skin softener to his fingers	and wrapped them in surgical gauze. While lighting a cigarette a few moments later the gauze and an	inflammable substance in the skin softener were ignited and the burns resulted. The injuries were not believed serious, but after can-	celing the Dallas engagement Rachmaninoff left immediately for his home in New York for treatment.
