A reminder that Serge's Rachmaninoff's only concert in Paris will take place next Friday, the 23rd of this month, at 9 p.m., at the Salle Pleyel, to benefit charities in the Russian community. The program includes the great classics by Mozart, Beethoven, and Chopin. But, for the first time, the great composer and virtuoso will perform Debussy's Children's Corner. Thus, we will be able to hear this delightful work by the famous French master performed by the greatest Russian pianist. His own works will also be part of the program. Finally, he will perform several works by Borodin, whose centenary is being celebrated this year.
